

A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE 2023 PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE 2022-68, ADDING FUNDS

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of West Lafayette, State of Ohio as follows:

SECTION I: That there be and hereby an addition to the following funds as follows:

101.101.521100	\$20,800.00
101.101.521110	\$ 1,000.00

In the 101 General Fund, funds are needed to cover Police Department wage expenses, electric bills, and Village Solicitor fees for the remainder of 2023.

218.101.521100 **\$34.18**


In the 218 Police Levy fund, additional funds were received from the police levy money above what was anticipated and needs to be appropriated to pay for police department wages.

In the 602 Sewer Fund, funds are needed to cover the 1st installment of the OWDA Loan #9952 for the Sewer Outfall Project.

SECTION II: That this Resolution shall be declared an emergency measure necessary to preserve the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of the Village of West Lafayette, Ohio, the emergency being to assure timely payments to vendors and shall take effect immediately upon passage by Council and signing of the Mayor.
