**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO FILE AN APPLICATION TO THE OHIO ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION AGENCY TO PARTICIPATE IN THE OHIO EPA RECYCLE OHIO GRANT PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, funds are available to be awarded to support scrap tire amnesty and cleanup events sponsored by solid waste management districts through the Ohio EPA Recycle Ohio Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the Village of West Lafayette, Ohio desires to participate in the Community and Litter Grant Program to receive financial assistance to hold scrap tire mitigation collections, cleanup events and recycle organic materials; and

WHEREAS, the Village of West Lafayette, Ohio has the authority to apply for financial assistance and to administer the amounts received from the state of Ohio Environmental Protection Agency; and

WHEREAS, participation in the Recycle Ohio Grant Program requires compliance with all the terms, promises, conditions, and assurances as outlined in the 2025 Recycle Ohio Grant Application including, but not limited to, the requirement to charge a fee of \$.50 per scrap tire collected as part of the scrap tire mitigation collection and cleanup events as conditioned pursuant to R.C. 3736.05(C);


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of West Lafayette, State of Ohio as follows:

Section 1. That the Council of the Village of West Lafayette authorizes and directs the Village Administrator to prepare and submit the Recycle Ohio Grant Application to the Ohio EPA for financial assistance to hold scrap tire mitigation collections, cleanup events and recycle organic materials and provide all information and documentation required in said Application for submission.


Section 2. That the Council of the Village of West Lafayette hereby understands and agrees that participation in the program will require compliance with program guidelines and assurances including, but not limited to, charging a fee of \$.50 per scrap tire collected as part of the scrap tire mitigation collection and cleanup events.

Section 3. That this resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure and its immediate passage is necessary in order to preserve, protect and maintain the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of West Lafayette, Ohio and must be passed in order for the application to be submitted prior to the deadline of December 6, 2024. Therefore, this Resolution shall be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.
