**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND/OR VILLAGE ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE AND SUBMIT AN APPLICATION FOR THE ABANDONED MINE LAND ECONOMIC REVITALIZATION, (AMLER), GRANT PROGRAM THROUGH THE OHIO DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES.**

**WHEREAS**, the State of Ohio through the Ohio Department of Natural Resources, awards and administers sub-grants of Abandoned Mine Land Economic Revitalization (AMLER) funds received from the federal Office of Surface Mining Reclamation and Enforcement (OSMRE); and

**WHEREAS**, the Village of West Lafayette desires financial assistance under the Abandoned Mine Land Economic Revitalization (AMLER) Grant to make improvements and amenities for the community at Waterworks Park, such as, a splash pad, soccer field, baseball field, walking trail, picnic shelters, benches, trees, restrooms, lighting and security.

**NOW, THEREFORE**, be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of West Lafayette, State of Ohio as follows:


**Section 1:** That the Council of the Village of West Lafayette approves filing this application for financial assistance, the amount to be determined by the project engineer based on the design estimates less the in-kind contributions and match dollars.

**Section 2:** That the Mayor and/or Village Administrator are hereby authorized and directed to execute and file an application with the Ohio Department of Natural Resources and to provide all information and documentation required to become eligible for possible funding assistance.


**Section 3:** That the Council of the Village of West Lafayette does agree to obligate the funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and become eligible for reimbursement under the terms of the Abandoned Mine Land Economic Revitalization (AMLER) program.

**Section 4:** That the Council of the Village of West Lafayette does agree to accept in-kind contributions of time and materials and matching funds and agrees to obligate the remaining funds required to satisfactorily complete the proposed project and according to the terms of the grant agreement.
