**A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE POLICE CHIEF AND/OR FISCAL OFFICER TO FILE AN APPLICATION
TO THE OFFICE OF CRIMINAL JUSTICE SERVICES (OCJS) FOR THE STATE OF OHIO VIOLENT CRIME
REDUCTION GRANT PROGRAM AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY**

WHEREAS, funds are available to be awarded in three tiers through the OCJS Violent Crime Reduction Grant Program; and

WHEREAS, the Village of West Lafayette, Ohio desires to participate in the OCJS Violent Crime Reduction Grant Program to receive financial assistance to purchase flock cameras for the village that will assist with investigations; and


WHEREAS, the Village of West Lafayette, Ohio has the authority to apply for financial assistance and to administer the amounts received from the OCJS Violent Crime Reduction Grant Program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of West Lafayette, State of Ohio as follows:

Section 1. That the Council of the Village of West Lafayette authorizes and directs the Police Chief and/or Fiscal Officer to prepare and submit the Violent Crime Reduction Grant Program application and to provide all information and documentation required in said Application for submission.

Section 2. That this resolution is hereby declared an emergency measure and its immediate passage is necessary to preserve, protect and maintain the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of the Village of West Lafayette, Ohio and must be passed for the application to be submitted prior to the deadline of January 8, 2026. Therefore, this Resolution shall be in force immediately upon its passage and approval.
