**A RESOLUTION TO AMEND THE 2026 PERMANENT APPROPRIATIONS ORDINANCE
2025-63, ADDING FUNDS**

BE IT RESOLVED by the Council of the Village of West Lafayette, State of Ohio as follows:

SECTION I: That there be and hereby an addition to the following funds as follows:

101.101.525000 **\$3,000.00**

In the 101 General Fund, funds are needed to purchase new computers for the police cruisers.

103.801.526110 **\$6,136.53**

103.801.526111 **\$1,297.82**

In the 103 Police Department Debt Service Fund, funds will be transferred from the General Fund to cover the debt obligations for the annual loan payments and those transferred funds need appropriated.

265.000.599999 **\$50,000.00**

In the 265 ARC Ready Grant fund, and advance was made from the General Fund in the amount of \$50,000 in May 2025 and will need advanced back to the General Fund once the grant proceeds are received.



In the 602 Sewer Fund, additional funds are needed to cover the annual OPWC loan payment.

SECTION II: That this Resolution shall be declared an emergency measure necessary to preserve the health, welfare and safety of the citizens of the Village of West Lafayette, Ohio, the emergency being to timely meet the Village's contractual obligation for timely payments and shall take effect immediately upon passage by Council and signing of the Mayor.
