A RESOLUTION BY THE COUNCIL OF THE VILLAGE OF WEST LAFAYETTE, COSHOCTON COUNTY, OHIO, AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO SUBMIT A GRANT APPLICATION WITH THE FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY, (FEMA), FOR THE BUILDING RESILIENT INFRASTRUCTURE AND COMMUNITIES, (BRIC), GRANT; AND IF THE GRANT OFFER IS RECEIVED, FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND FISCAL OFFICER TO EXECUTE THE GRANT CONTRACT AND ALL RELATED DOCUMENTS AND AUTHORIZING THE VILLAGE OF WEST LAFAYETTE TO ACCEPT ANY GRANT MONEY AWARDED AND DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

WHEREAS, the Federal Emergency Management Agency, (**FEMA**), provides grant funds for PRE and POST emergency or disaster related projects to support critical recovery initiatives, innovative research and many other programs; and

WHEREAS, the Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities (**BRIC**), is a Hazard Mitigation Assistance (**HMA**) grant program that makes federal funds available to local governments for hazard mitigation activities by recognizing the need to upgrade infrastructure to protect communities against the growing risks of natural hazards; and

WHEREAS, the Village of West Lafayette desires to apply for this funding assistance through the Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities, (**BRIC**), for the feasibility study and design of the Lafayette Mills detention basin to mitigate flooding there and throughout the Village, in the amount of \$450,000.


NOW, THEREFORE, be it Resolved by the Council of the Village of West Lafayette, State of Ohio as follows:

Section 1: That the Council of the Village of West Lafayette approves filing this application for financial assistance under the Building Resilient Infrastructure and Communities, (BRIC), Grant.



Section 3: That this Resolution shall be declared an emergency for the necessity of health, safety and welfare of the citizens of West Lafayette, Ohio for reason being that the grant application deadline is May 29, 2026 and shall be effective upon passage and signing by the Mayor.


