West Lafayette Village Council met in regular session on February 10, 2025 at 7:00 p.m. in the municipal building with Mayor Jessica Tubbs presiding.

Rich Wheeler, Jason Hursey, Brittany Howell, Adam Fisher and Christie Maurer were present. Councilman Tim Cheney was not present. Police Chief Morgan Eckelberry and Boy Scouts were also present.

Department Reports:

Fire: See attached 2024 Annual report and January 2025 Monthly report, read by Councilman Adam Fisher.

Fiscal Officer: Fiscal Officer, Amy Bourne, reported that Resolution 2025-02 will receive its third and final reading authorizing the village to sell surplus items via internet auction for 2025. Ordinance 2025-05 will receive its second reading authorizing the village to sell a vacant lot located at the corner of Main and Orchard St. Ordinance 2025-06 will receive its second reading to regulate inoperable vehicles in the village. Updates were made to it from the prior meeting regarding abandoned vehicles. Resolution 2025-07 will receive its first reading adopting the 2025 version of the Ohio Basic Code. January end of month cash summary was presented to the finance committee this evening. Bills were passed for approval.

Solicitor: Village Solicitor, Joel Blue, reported that the engineering contract for the sidewalks is done. He also reported talking to Gulfport regarding the letters the Fire and Police departments received regarding the gas royalties they receive and found they will be aggregating several properties together, which could be a reduction in dollars received.

Village Administrator: Village Administrator Tammy Hicks reported the contracts were singed for the sidewalk projects for this year and field work will be starting soon with the project to start in the Spring. The ad for the village-wide trash service has been published.
