West Lafayette Village Council met in special session on July 2, 2024 at 7:00 p.m. in the municipal building with Mayor Jessica Tubbs presiding.

Mayor Tubbs reported that the special meeting is to present a resolution regarding the storm sewer outfall project and that Brad Olinger with the Thrasher Group is present to speak about the bids received for the project. Mr. Olinger presented Council with packets containing details on the bid received. He stated that many contractors were contacted but only 1 bid was received due to the rushed timeline to complete the project, which is by the end of the year. The bid was for \$3,610,605 and along with the bid, there will also be a change order presented upon signing to remove the vac truck from the bid due to the long lead time to receive the truck. Removing this from the project will reduce the project cost by roughly \$293,000.
